

## REGIONAL FORECAST

A few showers and storms are possible across the region on Wednesday as a cold front will gradually push through the area. Highs will be in the lower 70s ahead of this frontal boundary. Forecast models currently indicate that this front will stall to the southeast of the region and an area of low pressure will develop along this front on Thursday. This area of low pressure is then expected to slowly move northward into the upper Midwest on Friday and into the upcoming weekend. If this holds true, periods of showers will be possible across the region each day from Thursday through Sunday. Temperatures will also be cooler. Drier conditions look to develop throughout the region early next week.
